RoHs3 Compliance for: General Declaration

In 2003, the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union passed the “Restriction of Hazardous Substances” Directive. The RoHS Directive was recast March 31, 2015 as Directive 2011/65/EU. This Directive restricts the use of the following 10 specific substances in electrical and electronic equipment sold in the EU beginning March 31, 2015:

EU RoHS specifies maximum levels for the following 10 restricted substances. The first six applied to the original RoHS while the last four were added under RoHS 3, which took effect July 22, 2019.

Cadmium (0.01 %)
Lead (0.1 %)
Mercury (0.1 %)
Hexavalent chromium (0.1 %)
Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1 %)
Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1 %)
Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1 %)
Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1 %)
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1 %)
Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)
